Jonathan Kealing, 24, is online editor for The World Company in Lawrence, Kan.

He oversees daily operations of LJWorld.com and KUSports.com, and he helps chart the strategic direction of a group of Web sites serving smaller communities in Northeast Kansas, plus KTKA.com

(Topeka) and TheDriveShow.com.

He's a member of the senior newsroom management team, which includes representation for the Lawrence Journal-World and 6News in addition to the online operation. The World Company has long been a leader in merging media and Web development, which was noted in a exclusive profile of the World Company in a Page One story in The New York Times a few years ago.

Before graduating from the University of Kansas in 2007, Kealing worked for the Austin Business Journal, the Des Moines Register, the Kansas City Star and the Lawrence Journal-World. He started with the Journal-World after graduation, covering higher education before taking being promoted to his current position in 2008.
